

# Supplying Your Own Drinks

If you'd like to supply your own drinks during the daytime, there are a few things to consider, including how much to buy. Our suggestions below will give you a breakdown of levels to ensure everyone has plentiful drinks throughout the drinks reception and dinner but you won't be left with too many bottles to transport post event! Please also read the info at the bottom of the page.

Based on 100 guests attending, 1:30pm Drinks Reception, 6:30pm Dinner Ends

## Post Ceremony

Pimms: 6 70cl Bottles Lemonade: 12 1.5ltr Bottles  
2 Bunches Mint, 2 Cucumber, 3 Punnets Strawberries  
2 Oranges, 6 Lemons, 12 Limes

30 Bottles Prosecco/Champagne/Sparkling Wine (180 glasses)  
2 Bottles Elderflower Cordial, 12 1ltr Bottles Soda Water  
Childrens Soft Drinks - Fruit Juice Cartons

## Dinner Drinks

36 Bottles White Wine, 18/22 Bottles Red Wine  
6 Bottles Rose, 36 Bottles Still 1ltr Water, 24 Bottles Sparkling 1ltr  
Water Soft Drinks for Children: Fruit Shoots

## Toast Drink

18 Bottles Prosecco/Champagne/Sparkling Wine (108 Glasses)

## After Dinner

Tea Bags, Herbal & Decaf - Instant Coffee (Good Quality)  
(Circa will provide sugar cubes, milk, crockery, jugs etc)

Daytime drinks service charge includes Circa providing: Lemons, Limes, Beer Bucket, Wine Coolers, Water Jugs, Large Kilner Dispenser, Ice and all Glassware.

Once the speeches have ended (at the end of dinner) we will not serve any more of your drinks.

You are not permitted to provide your own drinks in the evening at our venues.

You must deliver your drinks early in the week of the wedding to the venue (agreed with Circa in advance) or to our offices in Woodingdean, please allow time for this in the week before your event.

No alcoholic drinks are permitted to be served before the ceremony, spirits are not permitted to be served at any time. Circa staff will serve your drinks throughout, there is no 'self service' at our venues.

You are responsible for packing any left over drinks into an appropriate vehicle at the end of the night of the wedding as you do not have access to the venue the next day.

Bar is open throughout the day alongside what you have provided.
